BACK TOGETHER AGAIN! Welcome to the 2021- 2022 school year! I hope this letter finds you well and enjoying the final days of summer vacation. Every Community School staff member has been preparing for the return of all our great students. Every new school year, there is a lot of excitement for our students to look forward to including new teachers to meet, new books to read, new friends to make, and new skills to master.

Below is some important information regarding school opening:

COVID 19 SAFETY:

To begin the school year safely, all students and staff are required to wear a facemask when social distancing is not possible. In addition, all families must complete a COVID-19 clearance form for their child(ren). This form is on the district website under the *Parent/Student Link* tab. Complete this form before the first day of school. Finally, every classroom and the cafeteria is equipped with a powerful air purifier that kills surface and airborne SARS-CoV-2 virus that causes COVID-19.

FIRST DAYS OF SCHOOL

- Thursday, September 2, 2021 *Enter through Gym* (8:20 AM 12:20 PM no lunch served)
- Friday, September 3, 2021 (8:20 AM 12:20 PM no lunch served)
- Monday, September 6, 2021 School Closed Labor Day

FULL DAYS BEGIN:

Tuesday, September 7, 2021 (8:20 AM – 3:00 PM)

MORNING ENTRANCE INTO SCHOOL:

ALL students enter through the cafeteria door – *NO ONE WILL ENTER THROUGH THE GYM* (except the first day of school).

- Registered REACH students may arrive at 7:10 AM
- Non REACH students should arrive no earlier than 8:00 AM
- Students are late after 8:20 AM

AFTERNOON DISMISSAL:

All students are dismissed at 3:00 PM by grade level through the front main doors. PM REACH students remain in the building for the program.

SCHOOL SAFETY:

The city has provided school crossing guards at designated intersections to ensure the safety of our students. Students must use only these guarded intersections when crossing the street. Would you please stress with your child the importance of crossing at these designed intersections only? These designated intersections are:

- Route 30 and Philadelphia Avenue
- Claudius Street and Philadelphia Avenue
- Claudius Street and Buffalo Avenue
- Diesterweg Street and St. Louis Avenue
- Duerer Street and Buffalo Avenue
- Diesterweg Street and Havana Avenue

*Subject to change as deemed necessary by the administration and EHC Police Department

All car riders should utilize Diesterweg or Havana Avenues for drop-off and pick-up purposes. Lastly, for the safety of our bus riders, please do not park or wait in the bus loop during drop-off and dismissal times.

BREAKFAST & LUNCH:

Breakfast and lunch are available to all children. All families should complete a Free & Reduced Lunch Meal Application. BOTH breakfast and lunch costs are free for all students for the 2021-2022 school year. Lunch is served each full school day (lunch is not served on 12:20 PM dismissal days).

AM/PM REACH SIGN-UP:

REACH is our free before and after school program for students in grades 3-8. An informational flyer with a QR Scan Code for easy online registration is included with this mailing. Sign up as soon as possible as space is limited.
