PERSONAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION DEVICES

The Egg Harbor City Board of Education permits the possession and use of wireless electronic devices and cellular telephones on school property where it is supportive of staff and student safety, the general school building welfare, and academic/extracurricular education programs.

All wireless and cellular telephone devices must be turned off and stored in a locker or book bag during school hours. Disruption of the teaching and learning process will result initially in confiscation of the cellular telephone. Further disruptions will result in disciplinary actions.

Staff shall not use personal communication devices and email while on duty unless the use of such devices is related to their job responsibilities.

The board takes no responsibility for the loss or theft of such devices.
